Duties and responsibilities of the TWG:

- 1. Research the legality of the provisions of the proposed CNA based on the existing Civil Service Rules and Public Sector Labor Management Council rules and regulations on Collective Negotiation
- 2. To submit report to the CNA Committee-Management Panel stating its findings/recommendation on the proposed CNA.
