**DEPARTMENT ORDER** ) **SUBJECT: DELEGATED AUTHORITIES FOR**  
No. **11** ) **REGIONAL DIRECTORS AND DISTRICT**  
Series of 2007 ) **ENGINEERS IN THE PROCUREMENT**  
 ) **OF INFRA-RELATED GOODS**

In the interest of the service and for clarification purposes, the delegated authorities for Regional Directors and District Engineers in the procurement of infra-related goods (i.e., construction and maintenance supplies, materials and equipment) are hereby reiterated as follows:

1. For infra-related goods that are allowed for stocking purposes (for routine maintenance):
  - 1.1 Regional Directors - ₱1,000,000.00 per purchase request
  - 1.2 District Engineers - 750,000.00 per purchase request
2. For infra-related goods that are needed for a specific infrastructure project that is authorized to be undertaken by administration or force account, the concerned Regional Director or District Engineer is authorized to procure the necessary supplies/materials as specified in the approved program of work or bill of materials. This Order hereby confirms that the authority to undertake a project by administration actually carries with it the corresponding authority to procure the necessary supplies and materials for the said project.

It is understood that the abovementioned procurement authorities include the corresponding authorities to approve documentation requirements such as the Procurement Plan, Purchase Request, Resolution of Award, Purchase Order or Supply Contract, and Payment Voucher.

All procurement shall strictly adhere to the pertinent provisions of R.A. No. 9184, its Implementing Rules and Regulations, DPWH procurement policies and guidelines and other existing accounting and auditing rules and regulations.

This Order revokes D.O. No. 93, series of 1990, and supersedes other previous issuances inconsistent herewith.

This Order takes effect immediately.
