SUBJECT: Declaring Some City Roads in Davao City
as National Secondary Roads

Pursuant to the provisions of Executive Order No. 113, series of 1955, as amended, and Executive Order No. 459, series of 1975, the following city roads in Davao City as shown hereunder are hereby declared as national secondary roads, provided that the 20-meter minimum right-of-way for titled lands, 60 meters for unpatented public lands and 120 meters for land in forested areas have already been acquired:

1. Davao City - University Road ----- 7.801 kms.
(This is a loop road along Davao - Bukidnon National Rd.,
starting at Km. 355.056 and ending at the same station.)
2. Inawayan - Baracatan Rd. ----- 16.900 kms.
Km. 331.871-Km. 348.771
3. Ma-a-Davao City Diversion Rd. ----- 1.640 kms.
Km. 358+320-Km. 359.960

TOTAL ----- 26.341 kms.

This Ministry Order takes effect only after submission to and acceptance by the Ministry of Public Works and Highways the documentary evidence that the pertinent minimum road right-of-way has been actually acquired.
