SUBJECT: CREATION OF TASK FORCE ON  
MERIT PROMOTION BOARDS

Pursuant to Presidential Decree No. 807, the Civil Service Decree of the Philippines and the DPWTC Five-Year Personnel Management and Development Plan, a Task Force on the Activation of Merit Promotion Boards is hereby created under the Office of the Assistant Secretary for Personnel Management and Development, this Department.

A. Functions:

The task force is charged with the following functions:

1. Review of existing Merit Promotion Boards, their organization, mechanics, practices and accomplishments.
2. Preparation of administrative issuance embodying revisions appropriate for the requirements of each line agency and attached corporation.
3. Installation of Promotion Boards in each of the participating line agency and attached corporation.
4. Design instrument for Periodic Evaluation of the Boards.
5. Monitor operation of Boards to discern whether the operationalization jibes with stated objectives.

The Task Force on Merit Promotion Boards shall be guided by the attached Program of Work. It shall cease to exist at the end of December, 1978.

Monthly accomplishment report shall be submitted to management not later than three (3) days after the end of each month.
