No. 19 Subjection of 2007 (15.07)	TRANSFERRING THE REPAIR AND MAINTENANCE FUNCTION ON THE TARLAC RIVER DIKE FROM THE AGNO RIVER FLOOD CONTROL SYSTEM PMO TO THE TARLAC DISTRICT ENGINEERING OFFICE

In the interest of the service and pursuant to the provisions of Sections 6, 23, 25 and 37 of Executive Order No. 124, series of 1987, the implementation and supervision of locally-funded projects for the repair, maintenance, rehabilitation and/or improvement of the Tarlac River Dike, which stretches from Tarlac City to Moncada, Tarlac, Region III, is hereby transferred from the Agno River Flood Control System PMO to the Tarlac District Engineering Office (DEO), DPWH-Region III.

As such, pre-construction activities, including procurement of civil works, project supervision, and/or the implementation of projects to be undertaken by administration for the repair/maintenance of the said dike shall be now under the functional jurisdiction of the Tarlac DEO. The implementation of foreign-assisted projects shall remain, however, with the Agno River FCS-PMO.

Relative to this, the funds intended for the repair/maintenance of the Tarlac River Dike shall, henceforth, be released to the Tarlac DEO.

The Assistant Secretary for Operations concerned shall oversee the implementation of this Order in coordination with the Regional/Project Directors concerned and shall submit a corresponding accomplishment report.

This Order supersedes previous issuances inconsistent herewith and takes effect immediately.
