DEPARTMENT ORDER) SUBJECT: Creation of a Steering Committee
No. 24) for the Manila International Port
X-X-X-X-X-X-X-X-X-X-X-X-X-X-X-X Project

In line with Presidential Decree No. 1284 and LOI No. 657, both dated 16 January 1978, there is hereby created a Steering Committee to be composed of representatives of the agencies mentioned under the said LOI No. 657, as follows:

- General Manager, Philippine Ports Authority - Chairman
- Representative, Department of Public Works, - Member
Transportation and Communications
- Representative, Budget Commission - Member
- Representative, Department of Public - Member
Highways
- Representative, Bureau of Customs - Member
- Representative, Metropolitan Waterworks - Member
and Sewerage System
- Representative, National Housing Authority - Member
- Assistant General Managers, Philippine - Members
Ports Authority

The Steering Committee shall formulate guidelines and policies for the effective and early completion of the International Port as instructed under LOI No. 657. The agencies concerned are enjoined to send responsible senior representatives who can provide decisions for and in behalf of their office directly to their respective agency heads.



The Steering Committee shall meet at least once a month or as often as may be necessary to carry out its responsibilities. If necessary it may call on any other pertinent government agency or instrumentality for assistance.

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As an execution arm of the Steering Committee there is created a Task Force which shall be responsible for the planning, design, construction, maintenance and field administration of the project as well as the control and management of funds. The Task Force shall implement the policies laid down by the Steering Committee. It shall provide the necessary Secretariat to serve the Committee. The Task Force shall be headed by a Project Executive Director to be designated by the PPA General Manager. He shall be responsible for the affairs of the Task Force including the approval of all disbursements and signing of all checks relating to the International Port. He shall select the most appropriate personnel from the PPA and other pertinent agencies to be detailed assigned or appointed to the Task Force.

This order shall take effect immediately.
