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SUBJECT: CONSTITUTING THE COMMITTEE  
TO REVISE THE STANDARDS  
SPECIFICATIONS FOR HIGHWAYS,  
BRIDGES AND PUBLIC WORKS  
PROJECT

The review/revision of the Standard Specifications for Highways, Bridges and Public Works projects has become inevitable in view of new developments in design and construction technology and the new direction and policies of the government aside from some laws that have been enacted and which affect the implementation of government infrastructure projects.

To cite a few instances, the Cabinet Standing Committee which had been authorized to approve contracts within certain limits had been abolished and its function taken over by the Executive Secretary; the CEDP Program under EO 87 would require the use of indigenous materials and labor-based equipment supported construction methods; BP Blg. 344 - Accessibility Law would require barrier-free facilities and features in public buildings and streets/highways.

In view of the foregoing, changes in the specifications would be required, and for this purpose, the Committee on the revision of the subject standard specifications is hereby created to be composed of the following:

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The Committee is authorized to create sub-committees from among their respective Divisions to facilitate review/revision thereof. The specifications for Highways and Bridges which will need minor modifications shall be submitted within a period of two months. The specifications for public works should be submitted three months thereafter.
