SUBJECT: RETENTION FROM EMK FUNDS  
FOR EQUIPMENT RENTALS.

The accumulation of unpaid equipment rental obligations through bills rendered to the DPWH Field Operating Units undertaking projects by Administration of Force Account over the past years from Calendar Year 1972 up to the present time has piled up to a sizeable amount (P442M), despite the concerted efforts being exerted by the Bureau of Equipment thru the Regional Directors and Regional Equipment Services to collect same.

In order, therefore, to preclude recurrence of accumulating voluminous accounts receivable outstanding and to avoid unnecessary time, efforts and paperworks spent in billing and collection, it is directed that 15 percent (15%) of EMK funds earmarked for maintenance by Administration be retained in the regional offices to cover the rental of maintenance equipment. This will be in accordance with LOI No. 925 as implemented by National Budget Circular No. 318, Item No. 1.4.6 "From the CDC released for the project, rental of equipment utilized in project implementation shall be deducted in accordance with the provisions of existing Public Works Laws, rules and regulations and shall be remitted immediately to the Bureau of Equipment which in turn shall deposit the same with the National Treasury as General Fund Income pursuant to PD No. 711. Provided that adjustments shall immediately be made if the amounts so deducted are in excess of rentals compiled on the basis of standard rates and actual hours used".

This order shall take effect on 01 January 1990 and any issuance inconsistent herewith is hereby revoked or modified accordingly.
