C. RIS Ad-hoc Committee

1. One (1) representative, Infrastructure Computer Center
(Committee Coordinator)
2. One (1) representative from each Regional Office


The Executive Committee shall provide the general direction in the formulation of the system design and shall oversee the conduct of the inventory.

The Technical Working Committee shall be responsible for the preparation of the Manual of Instructions on the Conduct of Road Inventories, the conduct of pre-inventory seminar/workshop, and the coordination of the physical execution of the road inventory.

The Ad-hoc Committee shall be responsible for the assignment of the permanent identification numbers for national roads and the update of the national road network maps for their respective regions.

The names of all representatives to the Ad-hoc Committee should be submitted to the ICC Project Manager on or before July 22, 1983. Members of this Committee shall be detailed on full-time basis at the Central Office (ICC Seminar Room) from the period July 25 - August 5, 1983.
