SUBJECT: Areas of Responsibility of  
Officials of the Department  
of Public Works & Highways

Pursuant to Sections 6 and 8 of Executive Order No. 124, dated 30 January 1987, which reorganized the Department of Public Works and Highways, the following functional areas of responsibility of officials of the Department are hereby delineated and assigned:

1. UNDERSECRETARIES

A. Undersecretary TEODORO G. GENER

1. Supervision of all operations of regional offices (including district offices, regional equipment services, and city engineering offices where the city engineers are deputized as ex-officio city highway engineers) and PMOs for projects in Luzon (Regions I to V and NCR).
2. Chairmanship of the Central PBAC for Infrastructure Projects.

B. Undersecretary TEODORO T. ENCARNACION

1. Supervision of all operations of regional offices (including district offices, regional equipment services, and city engineering offices where the city engineers are deputized as ex-officio city highway engineers) and PMOs for projects in Visayas (Regions VI, VII & VIII).
2. Chairmanship of the Central PBAC for Consultancy Services.

C. Undersecretary JOSE F. MABANTA

Supervision of all operations of regional offices (including district offices, regional equipment services, city engineering offices where the city engineers are deputized as ex-officio city highway engineers) and PMO's for projects in Mindanao (Regions IX, X, XI & XII).

## II. ASSISTANT SECRETARIES

All Assistant Secretaries shall be directly under the Office of the Secretary and shall report directly to the Secretary.

The Assistant Secretaries shall be responsible for the supervision, management and control of the respective services under them and shall exercise technical supervision over the work of their counterpart organizational units in the regional and district offices.

## III. BUREAU DIRECTORS

All Bureau Directors shall be directly under the Office of the Secretary and shall report directly to the Secretary.

They shall be responsible for the supervision, management and control of the respective bureaus under them and shall exercise technical supervision over the work of their counterpart organizational units in the regional and district offices.

In the discharge of their duties, functions and responsibilities, the foregoing officials shall exercise their respective delegated authorities as provided in Ministry Order No. 32, series of 1985, as amended by Department Order No. 42, series of 1987.

This order shall take effect immediately.
