Pursuant to Executive Order No. 124 dated January 30, 1989 and supplementary to Department Order No. 42 dated 19 May 1988, the areas of responsibility of Assistant Regional Directors are hereby fixed and delineated to establish clear lines of authority and for purposes of uniformity and consistency in the discharge of their respective functions and responsibilities:

ASSISTANT REGIONAL DIRECTOR FOR SERVICES

The Assistant Regional Director for Administration shall now be referred to as the Assistant Regional Director for Services. He shall assist the Regional Director in the overall supervision of the following divisions in the Regional Office:

- (a) Planning and Design
- (b) Administrative
- (c) Comptrollership and Financial Management
- (d) Materials Quality Control and Hydrology.

Additionally, he shall be the Chairman of the Regional PBAC for Infrastructure Projects, and the PBAC for Frocurement of Supplies, Materials and Equipment.

He shall likewise assist the Regional Director in the general supervision of similar and related functions pertaining to the Regional Equipment Service and the District and City Engineering Offices within the Region.

ASSISTANT REGIONAL DIRECTOR FOR OPERATIONS

The Assistant Regional Director for Operations shall assist the Regional Director in the overall supervision of the operational functions in the Regional Office pertaining to:

- (a) Construction
- (b) Maintenance
- (c) Equipment Services, and
- (d) The Office of the Regional Project Manager.

The Office of the Regional Project Manager has been created under a separate Department Order as the implementing arm of all regional offices, except the National Capital Region, in the execution of PMO projects in the region.

He shall also assist the Regional Director in the general supervision of similar and related functions pertaining to District/City Engineering Offices within the Region.

This Department Order revises and supersedes Department Order No. 79, dated 12 September 1989, and shall take effect immediately.
