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Subject : FULL INSTITUTIONALIZATION OF MULTI YEAR PLANNING

In accordance with Department Order No. 11 series 2015, for Roads and Bridges, and for other types of infrastructure, Multi-Year planning shall be conducted by the Regional Offices in coordination with Central Office Planning Service and its District Engineering Offices, as well as their adjoining Regional Offices.

Regional Planning and Design Divisions (RO-PDDs) have full responsibility for the preparation and annual update of the 3-year Rolling Infrastructure plans in accordance with DPWH's policies, standards, guidelines and procedures in the planning and design of highways, and other infrastructure.

The DBM and NEDA Joint Circular No. 2016-01 on Policy Guidelines and Procedures for the Formulation of the Three (3) - year Rolling Infrastructure Program (TRIP) issued on January 29, 2016 shall be used as the basis for preparation of Multi-Year plans. The planning process for Multi Year Planning and the nationwide Annual Infrastructure Program (AIP), is to be in accordance with the following timeline:

In support of the Department's initiative for improved planning, the planning procedures, together with the Multi Year Programming and Scheduling (MYPS) Application, are hereby adopted to effectively manage the program preparation process for all civil works projects.

The policies to be adopted in relation to the implementation of the Multi Year Planning Process and the MYPS application are as follows:

- 1. MYPS is the official source of information for all DPWH programs and projects from 2016 GAA onwards. All programs, including the NEP, HGAB and GAA are to be recorded in MYPS. All projects, irrespective of funding arrangements, implementing office or Memorandums of Agreement with other agencies, shall also be recorded in MYPS.
- 2. MYPS will allocate a unique Project ID and Project Component ID to all projects irrespective of the program, and provide a single source of program and project information throughout the Department. Detailed procedures are included in the procedures manual.
- 3. All civil works project components must be defined according to the conventions in the MYPS and have a work location, scope of work and target before they can be passed to the Project and Contract Management Application (PCMA) for monitoring.
- 4. The responsibilities of Central Office Planning Service, RO-PDDs, and District Engineering Offices are defined in Department Order No. 11 series 2015, the Planning and Programming Procedures Manual, the MYPS Operations Guide, the Multi-Year Planning Guidelines and the Planning Service Handbook.
- 5. All approved project modifications and realignments must be recorded in MYPS. In accordance with Department Order No. 12 series of 2015, Planning Service, Programming Division will load all approved modifications and realignments into MYPS, and monitor the National, Regional and District targets against the baseline in the GAA.

This Department Order supersedes Department Order No. 245 series of 2004 in relation to implementation of MYPS.

This Department Order takes effect immediately.
