DEPARTMENT ORDER NO. 134 Series of 1978

> SUBJECT: Amending Department Order No. 128, Series of 1978, re rating of contractors applying for prequalification to bid

The selection of highly-experienced contractors to undertake the construction of highway infrastructure projects at rates faster than ordinarily expected has become necessary to overcome the possible delays that may arise on account of the uncertainty of weather conditions. Giving a little more weight for the experience of the contractor in the evaluation of applications for prequalification to bid, or enter into negotiated contracts, for the construction of highway projects will to a great extent insure the selection of most capable contractors who could be expected to complete road or bridge projects ahead of completion schedule.

In view, thereof, it is hereby ordered that Section D, Paragraph 6, of Department Order No. 128 be amended, as follows:

- 6. Rating Based on the foregoing, contractors shall be rated as fodlows:
  - 20% weight 1. Net Contracting Capacity 2. Financial Resources - 20% weight - 25% weight 3. Equipment Resources 4. Experience of Proposed Staff - 20% weight - 15% weight 5. Experience of Contractor

This order shall take effect immediately.

Any or all provisions of any previous order, circular, memoranda to the contrary are hereby superseded.
