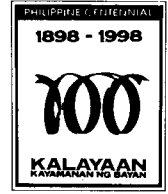

The Steering Committee shall coordinate, provide overall guidance, and monitor the conduct of the said Study, including the work of the Consultants, and shall review and evaluate the results and recommendations of the Study, for submission to the DPWH Secretary.

A Technical Working Group is also hereby created to provide technical support services to the said Steering Committee. This Group shall be headed by the DPWH Assistant Secretary for Planning and composed of personnel from concerned units of the Department as may be determined by the Steering Committee.

This Order shall take effect immediately.
