SUBJECT: COORDINATION WITH LOCAL GOVERNMENT UNITS IN THE IMPLEMENTATION OF INFRASTRUCTURE PROJECTS

In order to enhance the monitoring and implementation of all infrastructure projects and in line with the policy of the Office of the President as enunciated in a Memorandum dated 4 July 1990, copy attached, and the provision of the Local Government Code, particularly Section 524(b) thereof, quoted hereunder:

" x x x No infrastructure or community project within the territorial jurisdiction of any local government unit shall be undertaken without informing the local chief executive and the sanggunian concerned. x x x ",

all Regional Directors, Project Managers, District/City Engineers, and others concerned are hereby directed to establish rapport, coordination and cooperation with the local government units (LGU) by undertaking the following collaborative activities:

- 1. Conduct periodic consultation with appropriate LGUs, as well as non-governmental and peoples organizations and other concerned sectors of the community before any DPWH infrastructure project or program is implemented.
- 2. Furnish the Governors and City/Municipal Mayors in their respective jurisdictions copies of the approved DPWH Infrastructure Program for their respective areas including any approved realignments/amendments thereon;
- 3. Give them the lists of projects to be implemented within their areas of jurisdiction, including their implementation schedules and brief description of the scope of work to be done;
- 4. Post in a billboard to be placed at the project site, immediately upon award of the contract, the name of the project, the total project cost and the amount released for the project, the starting and expected dates of completion as well as the name of the contractor, which shall be maintained up to the date of completion and acceptance of the project; post in a billboard in the provincial/city/municipal building a summary list of these projects with said information.

6. Submit to the local chief executives regular (monthly) status reports and completion reports on projects being implemented in their respective areas; and request them to monitor/evaluate project activities as well as their observations thereon.

The degree to which Regional Directors, Project Managers, District/City Engineers and other concerned comply with this order shall be one of the bases for evaluating their respective performance.

This Order shall take effect immediately.
