SUBMISSION OF SITUATIONAL REPORTS ON MAJOR NATIONAL ROADS/BRIDGES DURING CALAMITIES

For immediate information and guidance of all concerned, all Regional Directors are hereby directed to submit to the Bureau of Maintenance, thru the DPWH Central Communication Center, their respective situational reports, during calamities, on major national roads and bridges within their jurisdictions.

The situational report shall include the following information using the format in Annex "A":

- 1. The name/location of the major road sections.
- 2. Situation of the affected major road section indicating whether passable or not passable.
- 3. Action taken on damaged sections (e.g. clearing, rehabilitation, restoration, etc.).
- 4. Preliminary cost estimate to repair/restore the damaged section.
- 5. Remarks, indicating whether the damaged section is open or not to all types of vehicle, detour routes available, and estimated time of repair.

The Regional Directors shall update and submit to the Bureau of Maintenance their respective situational reports every six (6) hours during calamities, i.e., at 8 am, 2 pm, 8 pm, and 2 am.

In the Central Office, the Bureau of Maintenance shall consolidate situational reports coming from the different Regional Offices using the attached reporting format (see accomplished sample - Annex "B").

This Order supersedes or modifies previous issuances inconsistent herewith and shall take effect immediately.
