MINISTRY ORDER

Paragraph No. 2 of Ministry Order No. 164, current series, is hereby amended to read as follows:

"2. During the calendar quarters when prevailing weather conditions are expected to be most propitious for road maintenance work, maintenance share of field offices shall be remitted in full by the Regional Office without retention for equipment rentals. However, in the calendar quarters when maintenance activities are usually limited because of adverse weather conditions, equipment rentals shall be retained by the Regional Office to cover current quarter rentals, as well as unpaid rentals for past quarters and/or advance rental retention for the coming quarters. The amounts to be so retained shall be determined by the Regional Director; after consultation with the District Engineer concerned as to the amounts corresponding to payment of past and/or future equipment rentals; provided, however, that if prior to the end of the calendar year, the Regional Equipment Engineer should certify that the total equipment obligation of a District or City Engineering Office is less than the amount retained by the Region, then the balance of such retentions shall be immediately released to the field office concerned and/or applied as advance payment for equipment rentals in the succeeding quarter of the next calendar year.

This order shall take effect immediately.
