**SUBJECT: TECHNICAL WORKING GROUP (TWG)  
 FOR THE LAGUNA LAKESHORE  
 EXPRESSWAY-DIKE PROJECT (LLEDP)**

To support the Special Bids and Awards Committee (SBAC) for the Laguna Lakeshore Expressway-Dike Project (LLEDP) as constituted under DPWH Special Order No. 106, Series of 2014, a Technical Working Group (TWG) is hereby, constituted to assist in the review and finalization of bidding documents and undertake the evaluation of the qualification documents and bids for the LLEDP, and to submit the results of the evaluation to the SBAC for review and recommendation to the DPWH Secretary.

The TWG shall be composed of the following officials:

  - Representative from Legal Service
  - Representative from Financial Management Service
  - Three (3) Representatives from Laguna Lake Development Authority
  - Representative from ESSD-Planning Service
  - Representative from Regional Office of Region IV-A
  - Two (2) Representatives from PPP Center
  - Two (2) Representatives from Department of Finance
  - Three (3) Representatives from PDMF Transaction Advisors

The TWG Head may request any official or staff of DPWH to provide inputs relevant to this undertaking.

This Order supersedes Special Order Nos. 107 and 107-A, Series of 2014 and other issuances inconsistent herewith, and shall take effect immediately.
