The Task Force shall conduct hearings on the formal charges filed against DPWH officials and employees involved in the alleged anomalous repairs of DPWH vehicles and motor parts.

The Task Force, through its Chairman, shall have the power and authority to issue subpoena duces tecum, administer oaths as well as authority to issue directive or orders as may be needed to accomplish its objective.

The Task Force shall provide the Office of the Secretary its finding/s and recommendation/s within sixty (60) calendar days after the issuance of this Order.

This order supersedes all previous issuances to the contrary and shall take effect immediately.
