Under and by virtue of this order, the Task Force is hereby authorized to coordinate with concerned offices of this Department. The Task Force primary objective is to act as the Secretariat of the NSSMP Committee (NEDA Infrastructure Committee (INFRACOM) Subcommittee on Water Resources). The NSSMP Task Force shall gather data on the number of local sanitation plans developed, number of projects developed, approximate number of people benefiting from the projects, amount of money spent nationwide and approximate amount of pollution diverted from the environment; and report these information to the NSSMP Committee annually starting in 2011. The NSSMP Task Force may use the DOH, DILG or LGU scorecards to monitor septage management and sewerage activities at the LGU level.
