RECONSTITUTION OF THE JOINT COORDINATING COMMITTEE (JCC) AND THE TECHNICAL WORKING GROUP (TWG)/TRAINING TEAM FOR THE CONTINUANCE OF THE REMAINING ACTIVITIES OF THE RECENTLY COMPLETED PROJECT ON THE "IMPROVEMENT OF QUALITY MANAGEMENT FOR HIGHWAY AND BRIDGE CONSTRUCTION AND MAINTENANCE"
