In order to facilitate the resolution of the issues and concerns in the termination of some contracts for the implementation of projects under the Saudi Fund for Development – Mindanao Roads Improvement Project (SFD-MRIP), which have incurred negative slippage of 15% or more and/or when the contractors have failed to comply with their obligation/s provided for in their respective contracts and/or committed act/s which constitute as ground/s for the termination of a contract, and in accordance with Clause 18.1 (f) of the approved Bidding Document on the Procedures for the Termination of Contracts, a **Contract Termination Review Committee (CTRC) for SFD-MRIP** is hereby created to be composed of the following:

Chairman - **Assistant Secretary for Support Services**
Members - **Director, Bureau of Construction**
Director, Legal Service
Director, Internal Audit Service
Regional Directors concerned
(DPWH Regions IX, X and XII)

When a ground for termination of a contract is being contested by the concerned Contractors in view of alleged peace and order situation prevailing at the project site, or non-acquisition of road right-of-way, the concerned Governor or his authorized representative or the Sangguniang Panlalawigan, the Provincial Director of the Philippine National Police and the Brigade Commander of the Armed Forces of the Philippines shall be invited as resource persons.

The CTRC shall review and evaluate all reports and recommendation submitted by the Implementing Office and the position papers submitted by the concerned Contractors relative to the projects or contracts in question, and shall submit its findings and recommendations to the undersigned within thirty (30) days from the time the proposed termination of contracts were referred to it.

Considering that the SFD Loan No. 1/433 will expire on 31 December 2012, it is necessary that the issues and concerns on the termination of the contracts are resolved as soon as possible to be able to implement and complete the balance of work before the expiration of the loan.

This Order shall take effect immediately.
