 SUBJECT: Creation of the DPWH Right-of-Way Manual Committee

The above-stated Committee shall be primarily liable for:

- 1. Ensure that the DRAM is consistent with the existing laws, rules and regulations pertaining to Right-of-Way (ROW) Acquisition;
- 2. Provide and/or supplement policies not yet covered by the existing DRAM such as, but not limited to, ROW acquisition for utilities, and processing Outstanding ROW claims;
- 3. Review and Revise existing ROW Policies and consolidate the same in the Revised DRAM;
- 4. Eliminate over-regulation in its ROW process consistent with Executive Order No. 23, series 2020¹ and Anti-Red Tape Act;
- 5. Provide a system of monitoring process of all ROW Claims for the Department; and
- 6. Recommend appropriate measures on all matters relevant to ROW concerns.

The above-stated Committee shall be assisted by a Technical Working Group (TWG) for the accomplishment of the said purpose. The Committee may call on any employee of the DPWH to assist in the revision of the said DRAM.

The Committee is hereby directed to submit its proposed revised DRAM within sixty (60) calendar days from this Order.
