DPWH, as the sole counterpart agency of JICA, shall coordinate the implementation of the Detailed Design (D/D) Study among the representatives of relevant organizations of the GOP, BARMM-MPW and LGUs etc.

The Technical Advisory Committee (TAC) shall be responsible in the following technical aspects:

- 1. Oversee the conduct of the overall work of the project in accordance with the project design activities and implementation plan;
- 2. Provide assistance to the Study Team in the conduct of field survey works, data collection and investigation;
- 3. Provide assistance to the Study Team in the coordination and consultations among stakeholders and local government units in the preparation of indicative relocation/resettlement action plan;
- 4. Provide guidance and resolve issues/constraints that may arise during the course of the study;
- 5. Monitor the progress of the study and evaluate the accomplishment of the targets and achievements of the objectives;
- 6. Review and evaluate the results and recommendations of the study;
- 7. Monitor the progress of the study; and
- 8. Ensure success and desired outcome of the study.

The TAC will be chaired by DPWH and meet at least five times as follows:

- At the timing of route selection;
- At during outline design explanation;
- At the timing of setting detailed design conditions;
- At the draft interim report explanation;
- At the draft final report explanation;

The Technical Advisory Committee may invite the concerned DPWH officials/personnel or other concerned agencies to participate and/or provide assistance in the conduct of the study, as the need arises.

The Technical Working Group is established to monitor and give advices on the progress of the Detailed Design Study and in order to work smoothly and efficiently with the JICA Study Team.
