SUBJECT: Blacklisting of Rolando C. Siccion Surveying Office (RCSSO)

Pursuant to Sec. 69.1 (b) Rule XXIII of the 2016 Revised Implementing Rules and Regulations (IRR) of Republic Act (R.A.) 9184, and in accordance with Department Order No. 49 series of 2023 dated May 18, 2023, this Blacklisting Order is hereby issued to **ROLANDO C. SICCION SURVEYING OFFICE (RCSSO)**. The findings and recommendations from the DPWH Central Office Bids and Awards Committee for Consulting Services (BACCS), stated in Resolution No. 2023-06, found the entity, bearing the PhilGEPS Registration No. 200611117251458265270 and located at 1449 A.H. Lacson Avenue, Sampaloc, Manila, Metro Manila, NCR, Philippines, to have submitted bids containing false information or falsified documents, thereby attempting to influence the outcome of eligibility screening or any other stage of the public bidding. Consequently, the entity is disqualified from participating in all government procurement for a period of one year, from May 18, 2023 until May 18, 2024.

The penalty relates to the procurement under Contract ID 22CSZ018-Consulting Services for the Environmental Impact Assessment, Gender-Responsive Social Impact Assessment, and Preliminary Right-of-Way Action Plan of the Metro Cebu Expressway Project, with a contract amount of Php 14,640,521.35. As an additional measure, the entity's account in the PhilGEPS website is also suspended.

In line with Section 10 of the "Uniform Guidelines for Blacklisting of Manufacturers, Suppliers, Distributors, Contractors and Consultants", as revised by GPPB Resolution No. 14-2020 dated June 25, 2020, the name of the blacklisted entity will be posted in the Consolidated Blacklisting Report (CBR) through the Online Blacklisting Portal within three calendar days from the date of effectivity of this Blacklisting Order. The entity's name will be removed upon the lapse of the penalty period. An accomplished copy of the Government Procurement Policy Board (GPPB) Blacklisting Order Prescribed Form-Appendix 1 is attached for further reference.

This Order shall take effect immediately.

Pursuant to Sec. 69 of Republic Act No. 9184 and upon the findings and recommendation/s of the DPWH Central Office Bids and Awards Committee for Consulting Services (BACCS) in its Resolution No. 2023-06, the undersigned, under Department Order No. 49 series of 2023 dated 18 May 2023, hereby issues this Blacklisting Order to the entity hereafter stated:

	Submission of eligibility requirements containing false information or falsified documents.
