SUBJECT: Declaring Cabatuan Bypass Road and Barotac Nuevo Bypass Road as National Roads and Realigning the Unpassable Portion of Iloilo-Capiz Secondary Road (Old Route), all under the Jurisdiction of Iloilo 2nd District Engineering Office (DEO), Region VI

Pursuant to the provision of Section 5, item (i) of Executive Order No. 124, dated 30 January 1987 authorizing the DPWH to classify roads and highways into national, provincial, city and barangay roads, the Cabatuan Bypass Road L=3.092kms, Barotac Nuevo Bypass Road L=1.763kms, are hereby declared as national roads under the jurisdiction of **Iloilo City 2nd DEO**, **Region VI** as shown in the table below:

In addition, pursuant to the Department Order (D.O.) Number 124, Series of 2016, to maintain the integrity and reliability of the information in the Road and Bridge Information Application (RBIA) system, the segment of the unpassable portion of the Iloilo-Capiz Secondary Road (Old Route) (S00216PN) located in barangay Gines Patag, municipality of Cabatuan, Iloilo shall be realigned to the Gines Patag Diversion Road, and the unpassable segment of the former shall be delisted from the national road network under the jurisdiction of Iloilo 2nd DEO.
