- Typographical error in the project title/description. "Acanyon" Bypass Road Road. See attached LGU Certification.
- The change in scope of work from construction of concrete to gravel road is due to the substantial volume of roadway excavation required along the project alignment. The excavation primarily consists of hard rock formations with cut heights reaching up to 60.00 meters on the left side and 22.00 meters along the centerline, necessitating significant earthworks, rendering the allocated funds sufficient to cover only up to the construction of gravel road (See attached Geo-resistivity Report).
- This revision results from the integration of standard roadway side cuts and adjustments to the vertical alignment to achieve a maximum gradient of 12% in cut sections, in strict adherence to the DPWH Design Guidelines, Criteria, and Standards (DGCS). These modifications are essential to ensuring the structural integrity, stability, and safety of the roadway while addressing the engineering challenges posed by the site's topography.
- The presence of the hard rock requires the Item 102(3)b Surplus Rock Excavation, which is calculated to be at 108,665.588 cubic meters which constitutes 87.40% of the total project cost. Consequently, the allocated fund is only sufficient to cover the construction of a gravel road.
- This project also includes necessary work items such as clearing and grubbing, individual removal of trees, surplus common excavation, and miscellaneous item such as Seedlings/Saplings for other Programs/Initiative, which constitutes 11.79% of the total project cost.
