 Drainage and Slope protection structures covers 3.70% of the total direct which cost intended for the cross drainage (Class II, 910mm dia. Pipe culverts) and grouted riprap (Class A) to prevent scouring at the inlet / outlet of the drainage.

 The Surface Courses also contributes to 25.87% of the total direct cost intended for the construction of 150mm and 230mm thick unreinforced concrete pavement.

 The addition of miscellaneous structures covers 0.52% of the total direct cost and is intended for pavement markings and metal guardrails essential to address road safety.

- Inclusion of component CW2 Construction of Road Slope Protection Structure, intended for slippery sections in order to address slope stability and safety of the motorist passing the roadway/structure.
- The substantial unit cost of CW2 is attributed to the following:
 - The provision of grouted riprap and stone masonry having a volume of 737.34 cu. m. and 11.56 cu. m., respectively.
 - The construction of one 2.4mx2.4m reinforced concrete box culvert to address drainage and installation of 4,999.86 l. m. steel sheet piles (w=72.8kg/m) in order to securely retain earth and resist horizontal pressure.
- The unit cost also has been evaluated and reviewed by the Bureau of Construction (BOC). See attached evaluation dated July 31, 2024.
- Attached are the following supporting documents: Approved Program of Works (POW), Approved Plan, BP Form 202, Certificate of Availability of Funds (CAF), Certificate of Reasonableness of Cost Estimate, Geotagged Photos, and GIS Map of the Proposed Project Work Location.

Based on our evaluation, the submitted request for modification of the said project is in order; hence, approval hereof is recommended.
