- 1. An adjustment has been made to the station limits, from K0023+012 K0023+0720 to K0023+012 - K0023+072, to accurately reflect the actual damage, as identified in the detailed engineering survey conducted by the DPWH-Marinduque DEO. This revision aligns with the official Road Condition Data.
- 2. The project design incorporates a Mechanically Stabilized Earth (MSE) Wall for road slope protection, which entails a higher unit cost, along with an additional lane within the project's entire length, resulting in a decreased physical target.
- 3. Furthermore, the discrepancy is also attributed to a typographical error, as **K0023+0720** does not conform to the standard format for stationing notation.

Attached are the following supporting documents: Form for Evaluation of Modification Request (DPWH-QMSP-03-01 Rev 01), BP 202, Certificate of Availability of Funds (CAF), Geotagged Photos, Location Map, Certificate of Reasonableness of Cost Estimate, Approved Program of Works (POW), Detailed Unit Price Analysis (DUPA), Detailed Engineering Design (DED) Plan, and Straight Line Diagram (SLD)
