Justification:

- Change in the project limits due to:
 - Deletion of project limits K1320+932 K1321+015.945, K1330+669 K1330+802, K1330+989 K1331+075 and K1334+058 K1334+135, To tap with the on-going projects under FY 2023 with the same scope of works.
 - To prioritize sections with urgent need of rehabilitation / reconstruction to address dilapidated road surface due to its current condition and to address road safety to the travelling public.
- Increase in the unit cost/decreased in physical target by 0.332 lane km (from 7.364 lane km to 7.032 lane km), due to:
 - Earthworks covers 33.72% of the total direct cost, encompassing the removal of existing structures and obstructions such as asphalt pavements (with a thickness of 50mm), unreinforced PCCP (with a thickness of 250mm), RCPC pipes (1220mm diameter), as well as concrete structures and trees. Additionally, 14.42% of the total direct cost is allocated for embankment inclusion in earthworks, which is essential for filling areas requiring additional support.
 - Surface Course accounts for 36.22% of the total direct cost, involving a concrete pavement with a thickness of 300mm, as well as emulsified asphalt, bituminous concrete surfaces (wearing and binder) each with a thickness of 30mm and composite crack prevention geogrid at outer lane with 214.00 meter.

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- Drainage and Slope Protection Structure constitute 3.71% of the total direct cost, encompassing the installation of pipe culverts (with diameters 910mm and 1220mm), grouted riprap (859.09 cu.m.) and stone masonry (83.11 cu.m.).
- Miscellaneous Structure constitute 4.20% of the total direct cost allocated for concrete curb (5,890.11 l.m.), metal guardrails (380 l.m.) and pavement markings essential for road safety features.
- The derived unit cost is based on the approved Program of Works (POW) and Detailed Unit Price Analysis (DUPA).
- Attached are the following supporting documents: Approved Program of Works (POW), Approved Plan, BP Form 202, Certificate of Availability of Funds (CAF), Certificate of Reasonableness of Cost Estimate, Geotagged Photos, Straight Line Diagram, and GIS Map of the Proposed Project Work Location.

Based on our evaluation, the submitted request for modification of the said project is in order; hence, approval hereof is recommended.
