Guidelines and Criteria for Preparation and Appraisal of Schoolbuilding Projects and for Allocation of Funds

Enclosed, for your guidance and compliance, are the guidelines and criteria for the preparation and appraisal of schoolbuilding funds among regions/provinces/cities.

While the Ministry of Education and Culture (MEC), as the end-user of schoolbuilding projects, has the lead role in the application of these guidelines and criteria, the MPWH, through its district, regional, and central offices, is required to actively participate in this process, particularly thru the following;

- Provision of standard plans, specifications and cost a. estimates of schoolbuilding projects (p. 1, para 3 of the guidelines and criteria).
- Technical report from the District Engineer to support b. proposals to replace existing totally dilapidated/ damaged/makeshift and uneconomically repairable rooms/ schools (p. 3, item 2.1).
- Technical report from the District Engineer to support C. proposals to rehabilitate existing classrooms/schools (p. 3; item 3).
- đ. Technical report from the District Engineer to support proposals for the completion/improvement of existing schools/classrooms (r. 3, item 4).
- Advice to the MEC on the total budgetary ceiling for e. schoolbuildings (p. 7, para. 1),
- Incorporation of the priority list of schoolbuilding f. projects into the MPNH infrastructure program (p. 9, para. 2).
- Coordination with the MEC and the Ministry of Local q. Government in the application of the guidelines and criteria thru the Provincial and Regiona Schoolbuilding Committees (p. 9, para. 3),
