Among its tasks, the Committee shall monitor, evaluate, and coordinate the quantity, allocation, and release of water from the Angat reservoir and other multi-purpose dams for domestic and industrial consumption, irrigation, and power.

Each member agency shall coordinate with the other member agencies its activities, in relation to their programs to minimize the negative consequences of a drought.

The Task Force which shall meet from time to time as the need arises.

Periodic weekly progress reports of activities shall be submitted to the undersigned.
