Building Permits required for Government Buildings.

Be reminded that the National Building Code (PD 1096) does not provide for any exemption, whether public or private building, from securing building permits.

In accordance with existing law and regulations, all those concerned shall see to it that a Building Permit shall first be secured before any construction is started. However, in order to avoid delays in the implementation of building projects, an Excavation Permit may be issued by the Building Official concerned while the Building Permit is still under process. It is enjoined that the required standards sign (0.60 m. x 0.90 m.) indicating the Building Permit number and other pertinent data be posted at the site of construction.

The Certificate of Occupancy shall be immediately issued by the Building Official concerned upon completion of the project.
