SUBJECT: Amendment of Department Order
No. 14 Series of 1987 on
Minimum Equipment Requirements

Department Order No. 14 dated 1 April 1987 is hereby amended as follows:

"In order to apprise prospective bidders of their chances to award of a bid project, particularly on the aspect of equipment resources, it is hereby directed that, henceforth, the prequalification documents shall, aside from other requirements, contain a list of the particular type and number of minimum major equipment required to be owned or leased by a prospective bidder to complete a subject project, which list of equipment shall be submitted by the project proponent to the Prequalification, Bids and Award Committee (PBAC) concerned together with the request advertisement; Provided that said list of equipment requirement shall be discussed in the pre-bid conference. Accordingly, the PBAC shall duly inform the prospective bidders who have been disqualified within five (5) working days after disapproval stating therein the grounds for disqualification. Those disqualified shall be given five (5) working days upon receipt of notice but not later than ten (10) working days before the bidding within which to appeal for reconsideration.
