SUBJECT: Revised format of the Letter
of Acceptance for Completed
Highway Projects

The present format of the letter of acceptance for completed highway projects is hereby revised to conform with the conditions of the contract and the provisions of Presidential Decree No. 1759. The revised format is as follows:

"LETTER OF ACCEPTANCE

Gentlemen:

This is to inform you that upon final inspection of the above-mentioned project by an inspection team from this Ministry/Office, same was found to be satisfactorily completed in accordance with the plans and specifications of the contract.

The project is accepted as of _____, 19____, the date of its completion as reported by the Project Engineer.

It is understood that acceptance of this project does not relieve you of your obligation and responsibility of undertaking repair works on any failure that may occur in any section of the project within ONE (1) year from date of acceptance, as provided for in the contract. Neither does it relieve you of your obligation and responsibility pursuant to the provisions of P.D. 1759.

Very truly yours,"

For IBRD projects, the last paragraph of the above format shall be modified to read as follows:

"It is understood that acceptance of this project does not relieve you of your obligation and responsibility pursuant to the provisions of P.D. 1759."

This order shall take effect immediately.
