SUBJECT: REDELINEATION/REALIGNMENT OF RESPONSIBILITY AREAS OF ASSISTANT REGIONAL DIRECTORS

effective operations more and for a distribution of duties and responsibilities, the responsibility areas of Assistant Regional Directors previously fixed under Order No. 56 dated 19 May 1989 Department redelineated, as follows:

- The assignments/jurisdictions of Assistant Directors shall be territorial, instead of functional, in scope.
- Regional Operations shall be territorially divided into two groups of Engineering Districts/Field Operating Units, to be identified as Regional Area I and Regional Area II.
- Each Assistant Regional Director shall be responsible for one (1) Area: Within his area of responsibility, he shall
 - the Regional Director in the supervision of all administrative and operational functions.
 - 3.2 Act Chairman of the Regional as PBAC for Infrastructure Projects. and PBAC for Procurement of Supplies, Materials and Equipment.
- In assistance to the Regional Director, the Assistant 4. Regional Directors shall exercise supervision of those staff Divisions/Support Units in the Regional Office proper, including the Regional Project Management Office and the Regional Equipment Services, as the Regional Director may deem appropriate.
- 5. The Assistant Regional Directors shall discharge their assigned functions and responsibilities in accordance with existing laws, policies, rules and regulations.

The division of the Engineering Districts/Field operating units within the Region into two areas as hereinabove indicated, and the specific area assignment of each Assistant Regional Director, shall be determined by the Regional Director, subject to the approval of the Undersecretary concerned. In delineating the two areas of operation, the Regional Director concerned shall

take into account, among other things, the volume and value of projects being implemented/to be implemented by the Engineering District Offices/Field Operating Units in the Region. The Assistant Regional Directors may be reassigned from one Regional Area to another, to broaden their experience, knowledge, and skills.

Regional Directors shall submit to this Office, thru the Undersecretary concerned; their detailed reports on the implementation of this Order, not later than March 30, 1994.

This Order supersedes previous issuances inconsistent herewith, and shall take effect immediately.
