

MEMORANDUM TO: THE CHAIRPERSON, ECONOMIC SUPPORT FUND COUNCIL
THE MINISTER OF PUBLIC WORKS AND HIGHWAYS
THE TREASURER OF THE PHILIPPINES
THE MINISTER OF THE BUDGET
THE EXECUTIVE DIRECTOR, ECONOMIC SUPPORT
FUND SECRETARIAT

IN ORDER TO ACCELERATE THE IMPLEMENTATION OF SECONDARY SCHOOLS AND PUBLIC MARKETS PROJECTS UNDER THE ECONOMIC SUPPORT FUND, THE FOLLOWING DIRECTIVES ARE HEREBY ORDERED:

1. THE CHAIRPERSON OF THE ECONOMIC SUPPORT FUND COUNCIL AND THE EXECUTIVE DIRECTOR OF THE SECRETARIAT SHALL, IN COORDINATION WITH THE MINISTER OF PUBLIC WORKS AND HIGHWAYS, PRESCRIBE THE STANDARD CLASSROOM DESIGNS AND THE STANDARD PUBLIC MARKET MODULE TO BE UTILIZED BY PROVINCIAL, CITY AND MUNICIPAL GOVERNMENTS IN THE IMPLEMENTATION OF THESE PROJECTS.
2. FOR SECONDARY SCHOOLS AND OTHER PROVINCIAL PROJECTS, THE PROVINCIAL GOVERNMENTS SHALL ACT AS IMPLEMENTING AGENCIES. FOR PUBLIC MARKETS AND OTHER MUNICIPAL PROJECTS, THE MUNICIPAL AND CITY GOVERNMENTS SHALL ACT AS IMPLEMENTING AGENCIES. THE MINISTRY OF PUBLIC WORKS AND HIGHWAYS MAY BE DESIGNATED AS IMPLEMENTING AGENCY AS MAY BE REQUIRED.
3. THE CHAIRPERSON OF THE ECONOMIC SUPPORT FUND COUNCIL AND THE EXECUTIVE DIRECTOR OF THE SECRETARIAT SHALL ASCERTAIN A REASONABLE FIXED COST FOR EACH PROJECT AND ENTER INTO FIXED AMOUNT AGREEMENTS WITH THE IMPLEMENTING AGENCIES FOR THE EXECUTION OF THESE PROJECTS.
4. THE IMPLEMENTING AGENCIES SHALL BE RESPONSIBLE FOR CONTRACTING OF THESE PROJECTS UNDER APPLICABLE LAWS, RULES AND REGULATIONS. FOR THIS PURPOSE, THE IMPLEMENTING AGENCIES MAY UNDERTAKE SIMPLIFIED BIDDING PROCEDURES.
5. THE MINISTER OF THE BUDGET SHALL RELEASE ADVICE OF ALLOTMENTS AND CASH DISBURSEMENT CEILING FROM AVAILABLE FUNDS OF THE ECONOMIC SUPPORT FUND FOR THESE PURPOSES.

6. ALL PROJECTS TO BE IMPLEMENTED UNDER THIS DIRECTIVE SHALL
BE SUBJECT TO PRIOR APPROVAL OF THE PRESIDENT.
