SUBJECT: EXIT DIALOGUE UPON

CONCLUSION OF THE ROAD AND BRIDGE CONDITION RATING SURVEYS CONDUCTED BY THE BUREAU OF MAINTENANCE

As supplemental to Department Order No. 81, series of 2005, which reactivated the Road Condition Rating Surveys being conducted by the Bureau of Maintenance on semestral basis, it shall henceforth be made obligatory that an exit dialogue be conducted at the conclusion of every road condition rating survey to be held at the Regional Office which shall be co-presided by the Bureau of Maintenance Inspectorate Team and the Assistant Regional Director for Maintenance Operations with the District Maintenance Engineers and the Regional Maintenance Engineer strictly in complete attendance.

The exit dialogue will serve as the venue for preliminary airing out of the findings and to enable everyone to have an overall view of the road condition prevailing at the time of the inspection. Maintenance views, opinions, strategies, issues, suggestions and immediate priority activity needs of the road that maybe brought out during the dialogue could serve as guide of the District Maintenance Engineers in coming up with their own respective maintenance work plan to improve the condition of the road network.
