SUBJECT: CREATION OF A COMMITTEE TO STUDY  
AND DETERMINE ADDITIONAL REGULAR  
POSITIONS TO BE PROVIDED FOR  
PROJECT MANAGER OFFICES AND TO  
DRAFT PROPOSAL THEREFOR

It has come to the attention of this Office that actions of accountants, cashiers and property custodians in some Project Management Offices are being questioned by the respective resident auditors. Said employees used to perform their respective functions and discharge the responsibilities attached to their positions before all units under the defunct Ministry of Public Works and the Ministry of Public Highways were deemed abolished pursuant to the provisions of Executive Order No. 710 dated 27 July 1981.


In view thereof, a committee is hereby created which shall be composed of the following:

The said committee shall study and determine the additional positions to be provided in certain Project Management Offices. The positions to be so determined shall be the minimum required in order that the incumbents of said positions shall be able to discharge their duties and responsibilities in accordance with existing laws, rules and regulations.

The committee shall also draft the proposal to effect the inclusion of the additional positions in the itemized positions for personnel services of the General Appropriations Act for CY 1984.
