Subject: Delineation of Pavement Marking and Road Sign
Installation Functions in Metro Manila

To effect an efficient implementation of this Department's pavement marking and road traffic sign installation program in Metro Manila, a delineation of this function is hereby initiated effective immediately.

The Traffic Engineering Center (TEC) is hereby tasked with installation and maintenance of pavement markings and traffic signs on all signalized intersections, including proposed locations covered under the 1994-95 signalization program of that office.

The DPWH Regional Office, National Capital Region (DPWH-NCR) shall be tasked with the installation and maintenance of such markings and signs on road stretches of national roads (excluding signalized intersection locations) as covered under the regular and special maintenance activities of that Region.

The TEC and the DPWH-NCR shall be guided by Department Order No. 202, Series of 1992, and the international or duly promulgated Road Sign Standards and other pertinent guidelines, with regard to the implementation of these programs. Recognizing the importance of road markings and signs to public safety and convenience, both offices shall work hand-in-hand to fully equip all major roads with these required facilities.
