SUBJECT: <u>Creating the DPWH Communications</u>
<u>Management Committee</u>

In the interest of the service, there is hereby created a Communications Management Committee (COMCOM) which will oversee the effective implementation of a nationwide communication network for the DPWH. The Committee is composed as follows:

The functions of the Committee are as follows:

1. To conduct an annual inventory of all existing DPWH communication facilities.

- 2. To review and to recommend to DPWH management, changes and improvements in the existing communication infrastructure with the end-in-view of improving Central Office Communication with its Field Offices.
- 3. To manage the distribution and, to direct the efficient use and application of existing communication facilities and personnel in the operations of the DPWH.
- 4. To call on Officials and/or Offices of the DPWH to assist the Committee in the pursuit of its objectives.
- 5. To define the guidelines and procedures for future acquisition of communication equipment.
- 6. To supervise and coordinate the implementation of the DPWH-DND Memorandum of Agreement on the use of the DND nationwide communication network by the DPWH.

For purposes of this Order, communication facilities or communication infrastructures refer to existing and future (those to be acquired later) communication equipment such as transceivers (portable or base) and associated peripherals, telephones, telex machines, facsimile, modems, and others which are either components or accessories to the aforementioned equipment.

All issuances and/or circulars inconsistent with the provisions of this Order are hereby revoked or cancelled.

This Order takes effect immediately.
