SUBJECT: DECLARING AGUA DULCE STREET,  
FROM SAN PABLO UP TO C.  
AVILES STREETS, ORMOC CITY,  
A ONE-WAY STREET

On grounds of safety and convenience to the users of Agua Dulce Street in Ormoc City, which is still narrow and could hardly accommodate the heavy flow of cargo trucks and other vehicles passing through it, as pointed out in Resolution No. 36 of the Sangguniang Panlungsod of Ormoc, said Agua Dulce Street, from its corner on San Pablo Street up to its opposite corner on C. Aviles Street, is hereby declared a **ONE-WAY STREET**, pursuant to Sec. 10, Art. IV of Administrative Order No. 14, series of 1958, subject to the following conditions:

1. that a one-way road sign shall be installed;
2. that all vehicles passing through this road, designated and signposted for one-way traffic, shall be driven only in the direction as designated.

This Order takes effect immediately after compliance with the above-mentioned requirements.
