## INCREASING THE LIMITS OF AUTHORITY IN THE APPROVAL OF REQUISITIONS FOR SUPPLIES OR EQUIPMENT (RSE'B) AND OTHER RELATED MATTERS

LIMITS OF AUTHORITY

To further pursue the decentralization policy of the government and to provide for more effective and expeditious implementation of projects, the limits of authority previously delegated to the following DPWH officials concerned with respect to the approval of Requisitions for Supplies or Equipment (RSE's) for the requirements of offices/projects within their respective jurisdictions are hereby increased as follows:

CONCERNED FOR OFFICE USE FOR INFRA-RELATED SUPPLIES & EQUIPMENT SUPPLIES & EQUIPMENT Undersecretaries Above P500,000.00 Above P750,000.00 up to P 2 Million up to P 4 Million Asst. Secretary for Administrative Above P100,000.00 Above P250,000.00 and Legal Services up to P500,000.00 up to P750,000.00 Regional Directors Up to P500,000.00 Up to P750,000.00 Director III, Administrative and Up to P100,000.00 Up to P250,000.00 Manpower Management Service

It is understood that similar authorities previously delegated to other officials not mentioned herein shall remain in force and effect.

For this purpose, the prescribed Requisition For Supplies or Equipment Forms (RSE's) shall be used for requisitions for supplies not carried in stock. Requisition and Issue Voucher Forms (RIV's) shall be used for requisitions for supplies carried in stock by the requisitioning office.

Supplies and equipment for office use'refer to those items directly used in the day-to-day operation of the office while infra-related supplies and equipment are those directly used in the construction, improvement or rehabilitation of infrastructure projects.

This Order amends existing Department Orders and other issuances or portions thereof inconsistent herewith, and takes effect immediately.
