SUBJECT: Increased Limits of Delegated Authority to OICs of Sub-District Engineering Offices re Infrastructure Contracts and Related Matters

In line with the decentralization policy of the Government and to provide for more effective and expeditious implementation of infrastructure projects, the limits of delegated authority of the Officers-in-Charge (OIC) of Sub-District Engineering Offices with respect to nationally-funded infrastructure contracts and related matters for projects within their respective districts are hereby increased as follows:

Approval of plans, specifications, programs of work, and agency estimates for infrastructure projects

P 1,000,000

b. Conduct of public competitive bidding and resulting award, approval, and termination/rescission of infrastructure contracts

1.000.000

Approval of fund disbursements for infrastructure contracts approved by them

1,000,000

Approval of variation orders for d. and time extension of infrastructure contracts approved by them

Cumulative change from original contract cost/time not exceeding P50,000/15 days or 25%, whichever is less

e. Suspension of work under Section CI 9 of PD 1594-IRR not requiring time extension, i.e., for failure of contractor to correct bad conditions or perform any contract provisions

Contract cost up to P3,000,000

All claims for delays shall be submitted by the contractor for processing as time extensions. Time suspensions by the OIC of the Sub-District Engineering Offices shall not be issued unless there is prior approval by the Undersecretary concerned.

This Order amends existing Department Orders and issuances or portions thereof inconsistent herewith, and takes effect immediately.
