This is in view of the termination of contract of **EDISON DEVELOPMENT AND CONSTRUCTION** with address at 121 Le Mariche Condominium, E. Rodriguez Ave. Quezon City, as recommended by District Engineer Alex B. Ramos, Surigao del Norte 2<sup>nd</sup> District Engineering Office, and approved by OIC-Regional Director Pol M. Delos Santos, through a memorandum dated 17 September 2018, for the contract: 15NG0042 - Construction of 4-STY 20-CLR School Building at Dapa National High School, located in Dapa, Surigao del Norte. The subsequent Blacklisting recommendation was issued by Undersecretary Dimas S. Soguilon through a Memorandum dated 22 October 2018, for the violation of the terms and conditions of contract during project implementation stage. Hence, the blacklisting of EDISON DEVELOPMENT AND CONSTRUCTION is hereby **confirmed.** 

As such, **EDISON DEVELOPMENT AND CONSTRUCTION** is hereby **blacklisted/suspended for a period of one (1) year** from participating in any bidding of DPWH projects as and by the way of Administrative Sanction, pursuant to the Section 6.0 of Appendix 17, Uniform Guidelines for Blacklisting of Manufacturers, Suppliers, Distributors, Contractors and Consultants of the Implementing Rules and Regulations, as amended, of Republic Act 9184.

This Blacklisting order shall take effect immediately and shall not in any manner relieve EDISON DEVELOPMENT AND CONSTRUCTION from any financial obligations related to or connected with its terminated contract under the terms and conditions of the contract and existing laws, rules and regulations or such criminal liability under applicable laws, if warranted.
