SUBJECT : DESIGNATION OF FOUR (4) ADDITIONAL MEMBERS OF THE TECHNICAL WORKING GROUP OF THE CENTRAL OFFICE-PEAC FOR CONSULTANCY FOR THE EVALUATION OF THE PROPOSAL OF OPUS INTERNATIONAL CONSULTANTS, LTD. FOR THE ESTABLISHMENT OF THE ROAD BOARD SECRETARIAT AND DPWH ROAD PROGRAM OFFICE

This has reference to the provision of consultancy services for the establishment of the Road Board Secretariat and the DPWH Road Program Office (per RA No. 8794 and its Implementing Rules and Regulations) to be financed out of NRIMP-I loan proceeds from the World Bank. In its letter dated 21 November 2000, the World Bank stated that it has no objection to the DPWH undertaking direct contract negotiations for these consulting services with OPUS International Consultants, Ltd., which is currently doing a related work, i.e., the Road Management Reform Project under New Zealand Government assistance.

The Central Office-Prequalification, Evaluation and Awards Committee (PEAC) for Consultancy shall undertake the evaluation of the technical and financial proposals of OPUS International Consultants, Ltd. for the said consultancy services, and conduct the appropriate negotiations for the contract.

In view of the above, insofar as the said consultancy services are concerned, the following are hereby designated additional members of the regular Technical Working Group of the PEAC:
