**SUBJECT: CREATION OF THE DPWH
EARTHQUAKE RESILIENCY
PROGRAM MANAGEMENT
OFFICE (DPWH-ER-PMO)**

To ensure the effective and efficient implementation and alignment of the DPWH Earthquake Resiliency Plans, Programs and Strategies to the "Two-pronged Strategy towards an Earthquake Resilient Greater Metro Manila Area" consisting of immediate and long term measures to reduce risks and vulnerabilities of communities and strengthen critical infrastructures as defined under Executive Order No. 52 dated May 8, 2018 entitled "CREATING THE PROGRAM MANAGEMENT OFFICE FOR EARTHQUAKE RESILIENCY OF THE GREATER METRO MANILA", and to ensure an integrated department approach in addressing earthquake resiliency problems a DPWH Earthquake Resiliency Program Management Office (DPWH-ER-PMO) is hereby created with the following composition (organizational structure contained in "Annex A" hereof):

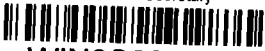
Attached is the Functions and Responsibilities of the DPWH-ER-PMO.

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FUNCTIONS AND RESPONSIBILITIES OF THE DPWH – ER – PMO

The **DPWH Earthquake Resiliency Program Management Office (DPWH-ER-PMO)** shall be headed by the Secretary as the Program Director with Undersecretary for Technical Services as Alternate, and assisted by Bureau of Maintenance Director and UPMO Director as Deputy for Operations and T/A, respectively. The functions and responsibilities of the DPWH-ER-PMO is defined under Department Order No. 75, Series of 2019.

The **Technical Steering Committee** shall have the following primary functions:

- a. Provide support, guidance and oversight of the overall performance and accomplishments of the regional operations;
- b. Establish policy decisions and ensure consistencies among existing plans and programs;
- c. Collect, analyze, review and evaluate situational reports and achieve feedback mechanism;
- d. Provide advice and feedback to the Program Director in ensuring the delivery of the program outputs and achievement of the program outcomes;
- e. Provide reports/news feedbacks to the Secretary, other related agencies and stakeholders and media; and
- f. Perform such other functions as the Secretary may direct/assign.

The **Support Services** shall have the following primary functions:

- a. Formulate long and medium-term development plans and resiliency programs in coordination with the Technical Steering Committee;
- b. Ensure funding source to be allocated for the implementation of the resiliency programs;
- c. Prioritize the allocation of funding for the long and medium-term development plans and resiliency programs; and
- d. Perform such other functions as the Secretary may direct/assign.

The **Regional Operations Groups** shall have the following primary functions:

- a. Operationalize the DPWH Earthquake Resiliency and Response Plan;
- b. Implement and institutionalize the Earthquake Contingency and Continuity Plan;
- c. Strictly monitor and fast track the implementation of urgently needed interventions to ensure resilient infrastructures;
- d. Conduct Vulnerability and Risk Assessment of all critical infrastructures;
- e. Ensure that the Key Result Areas as contained in EO 52 on Transport and Mobility is implemented and monitored;
- f. Collaborate/coordinate closely with LGU's in undertaking their plans and programs; and
- g. Perform such other functions as the Secretary may direct/assign.

The **Funding** for the whole operations of the DPWH ER-PMO shall be provided by the Department and shall be properly managed by the Program Management Office (PMO) through the Bureau of Maintenance (BOM) for the Operations and the Unified Project Management Office (UPMO) for the Technical Assistance following appropriate accounting and auditing procedures.
