- 1. Study and participate in the formulation of policies, rules, and regulations for the implementation and use of fiber, common poles, and in-building solutions, taking into consideration DPWH's mandate and functions;
- 2. Coordinate and collaborate with the Department of Information and Communications Technology (DICT), Department of the Interior and Local Government (DILG), and Department of Human Settlements and Urban Development (DHSUD) in all matters relative to the crafting of the JMC;
- 3. Ensure that the provisions in the JMC are consistent with existing Departmental issuances; and
- 4. Perform such other tasks as are necessary.
