Reason/s for Modification

- Modification is sought due to the problem in the acquisition of RROW. Upon inspection of the said location
 it was observed that Bantayan Extension once upgraded will affect most of the private properties, since
 the road will be raised to almost 1 meter.
- In as much that the newly constructed/rehabilitated Laguna Lake highway (formerly C-6) will be opened to the Motorist, the rehabilitation of Cayetano Avenue and the adjacent road leading to Laguna Lake Highway is greatly necessary in order to improve the condition of the roads and to provide convenience to the riding public that traverse this road section going to Laguna Lake Highway.
