#### Justification:

The proposed change in scope from "Off-Carriageway Improvement: Paving of Shoulders" and "Construction of Drainage Structure along Road" to "Preventive Maintenance: Asphalt Overlay" is deemed necessary and appropriate based on the current condition and status of the bypass road. The entire stretch of the bypass road has been fully paved and concreted with existing Shoulders and Drainage Structures, eliminating the need for such structures. See attached Multi Year Project Profile.

Additionally, the bypass road is currently under conversion to a national road, further justifying the shift to preventive maintenance to preserve and enhance the existing pavement. Given its strategic location, alignment is expected to accommodate increasing traffic loads, particularly from farmers and

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agricultural transport, as it connects production areas to key municipalities, trading hubs, and urban centers within Bukidnon. The project will help expand the distribution of agricultural goods, open additional opportunities for agricultural trade, and support rural economic development. The area expects growth and providing a network for connection enables traffic to be redirected from the national road.

- This project will utilize 50mm thick asphalt and will also include the following works:
  Provision of a 0.3-meter transition width on both sides of the outermost lanes to the shoulder throughout the entire project limits, to facilitate pavement surface smooth transition and enhance overall road safety and functionality.
- Re-blocking of existing concrete pavement along sections with road cracks before the asphalt overlaying.
- Provision of reflectorized thermoplastic pavement markings and Single Arm Solar LED Roadway Lighting to enhance road safety.

- To ensure longevity and structural integrity by including concrete joint sealant along longitudinal and transverse joints, as well as addressing minor cracks.
- The derived unit cost is based on the approved Program of Works (POW) and Detailed Unit Price Analysis (DUPA).
- See attached Certificate of Reasonableness of Cost Estimate signed and approved by the Regional Director.

Based on our evaluation, the submitted request for modification of the said project is in order; hence, approval hereof is recommended.
